We understand that the terms of this agreement cannot be changed unless agreed by both parties in writing. We confirm that we are not under 18 years of age, and reiterate that we do not object to copies of our wedding photographs being displayed for advertising purposes. ## Terms and Conditions

1. This booking form constitutes a contract between The David Bampton Studio Ltd and the persons named as Bride and Groom overleaf.
2. Bookings are accepted only when The David Bampton Studio Ltd is in receipt of Attendance Fee(s) and fully completed booking form.
3. Attendance fees are only for attendance by a David Bampton Studio Ltd photographer, or David Bampton personally at the Wedding and do not include photographs, or images in any form, or Albums.
4. The David Bampton Studio Ltd shall be the sole professional photographer at the venues specified.
5. If for any reason due to circumstances beyond our control (for example, bride very late), the wedding images produced do not cover the occasion fully, the client shall be bound by this contract to pay the full amount as agreed.
6. Any changes in the time or location of the wedding or reception should be notified in writing as soon as possible.
7. The David Bampton Studio Ltd shall be granted artistic licence in relation to the poses photographed and the locations used. The photographer's judgements regarding the locations, poses, and number of photographs taken shall be deemed correct.
8. Special requests for images must be made in writing at least 7 days before the wedding, however, it is understood that, whilst every effort will be made to produce them, this cannot be guaranteed.
9. Certain colours do not reproduce well on photographic film or on digital files, and whilst every effort is made to get as close a match as possible, exact matching cannot be guaranteed.
10. Weddings photographed more than 15 miles from the Studio will be subject to a travelling charge.
11. PAYMENT FOR WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHS shall be as follows:
  - i) The Attendance Fee(s) payable on booking. (These fees are non-returnable).
  - ii) An advance payment of £500 for a Studio photographer or £1500 for Attendance by David Bampton, is payable one month before wedding towards the subsequent cost of order, the balance to 50% of the total cost on viewing and ordering, and the final balance paid before the order can be collected (or finance agreement set up).
12. A specific range of Albums are included in the "Album and First \*\* photographs" price. An alternative Album may cost extra.
13. Extra photographs ordered by the bride and groom shall be treated as an extension of this contract.
14. All images ordered by persons other than the bride and groom, whether in person, by telephone, or internet require full payment with order.
15. No responsibility for error can be accepted unless the order is received in writing.
16. Photographs ordered at different times may be subject to colour variation.
17. All services and/or goods are supplied at the prices ruling at the time of order.
18. Cancellation of any order completed, or in the process of completion cannot be accepted.
19. Prices are subject to change without notice, and are inclusive of VAT at the current rate.
20. All sizes are approximate, and may be adjusted to suit the image.
21. The due performance of this contract is subject to alteration or cancellation by The David Bampton Studio Ltd owing to any cause beyond their control. In the unlikely event of photographic failure or cancellation of this contract by The David Bampton Studio Ltd, liability shall be limited to a full refund of all monies paid.
22. The Client may repudiate this contract at any time prior to the wedding ceremony by giving written notice to The David Bampton Studio Ltd. Should the Studio receive notice of cancellation less the 12 weeks prior to the wedding ceremony the Client shall pay The David Bampton Studio Ltd a total of £500 for a studio photographer booking, or £1500 for the booking of David Bampton personally. The said sum shall be payable as compensation towards the loss The David Bampton Studio Ltd would suffer. Should the cancellation be received in writing more that 12 weeks prior to the wedding ceremony, all monies paid to that date will be returned with the exception of Attendance Fee(s).
23. Any complaint must be received in writing not more that seven days after collection of the order.
24. In the unlikely event of an unresolved complaint the Client may request The Master Photographers Association or British Institute of Professional Photographers to act as independent arbitrators.
25. Images, (including images illegally downloaded from The David Bampton Studio Ltd website), according to the 1988 Copyright Act, remain the property of the photographer. It is contrary to the Act to copy or allow to be copied, the photographs covered by this contract, and person found to be doing so will be prosecuted.
